

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS



CARRIAGE DRIVING

- Vehicles are to be antique or reproductions thereof. More than one vehicle may be used under the same entry number for different classes in this division.
- Harness must be of the type appropriate to the type of vehicle used.
- Whips and their passengers should be dressed conservatively according to the style of the present day. Driving aprons, hats, gloves, and whip in hand are obligatory for drivers.
- Wire-wheeled vehicles are not permitted.
- Headers may be used for single hitches, but must come from within the vehicle. Multiple hitches must carry a header at all times.
- The Carriage Driving Champion will be awarded to the exhibitor / horse combination which accumulate the highest number of points throughout the show for competing in any carriage driving class listed below. In the event of a tie the highest placing in the reinsmanship class will break the tie. The following classes will be considered for this award: 113, 127 & 129. Points are accumulated on the following basis: First Place-5 points, Second Place-3 points, Third Place-2 points, Fourth Place-1 point.

SPECIALTIES

124	LEADLINE, RIDERS, 6 & UNDER	Sat. Morn
·	All riders in the leadline class must wear a helmet while mounted.	
·	Class is to enter the ring at a flat-footed walk. The class will be worked at a walk both directions of the ring at the direction of the Ringmaster. The rider will be judged on his/her basic horsemanship, the position in the saddle, hands, legs, seat, and back positions.	
·	The horse will be led by an individual 16 years of age or older. A lead strap must be attached to the bridle so that while the rider is on the rail the horse can be controlled by the leader.	
·	Judging will based on 50% of the riders horsemanship, 25% suitability of the horse and rider, and 25% on neatness and appropriate attire of rider and leader. May be shown under western, hunt, or saddle seat tack.

MORGAN BREEDERS CUP RULES

- The certificate qualifies you to compete in a class of 3 year old park harness horses at the Morgan Gold Cup horse show. You must declare your desire to participate by the closing date of entries for the show.
- Any 3 year old Morgan is eligible to compete for the class. The entry does not have to be sired by a stallion participating in the stallion service auction. Eligibility is determined by certificate. A certificate is owned by the purchaser of a stallion service or by the stallion service provider. **The owner's name on the certificate must match the owner's name on the registration of the horse entered in the class.**
- Certificates are good for only one year. The certificate must be presented in hard copy prior to the competition and will not be reissued, do not lose your certificate.
- This certificate may only be transferred if a voucher owner gives written notice that a certificate is sold with a horse. At that time, the certificate entry becomes applicable for that horse only. A copy of the transfer will be mailed to the new owner and must be presented along with the original certificate for entry into the class. To transfer the certificate with a sold horse, contact the Breeders Cup secretary for the proper transfer form.
